What We Learned

60%

of military and veteran families don't have enough in savings to cover three months of living expenses.



- Expanded MilCents, MFAN's financial education social learning program to add 12 new sections focused on smart investing.
- Increased MilCents outreach efforts leading to 11,042 unique participants in 2018, a 33% increase over 2017.
- Launched the Military Family Financial Readiness
 Coalition, convening 40 public and private organizations invested in supporting military family financial education.

15% of military and veteran families experience food insecurity.



- Developed a Military Family Food Insecurity
 Coalition, bringing together top anti-hunger and military
 family organizations to work collaboratively to combat the
 root causes of military family food insecurity.
- Built an interactive resource map to help families connect to local support services. In 2018, we added 1,257 organizations and events.

43%

of military and veteran families have chosen to live apart due to career and kids' education.



- Partnered with SEED SPOT, a social entrepreneur training nonprofit to train military spouses to become entrepreneurs.
- Created a social learning program, MilYou, that empowers military families to thrive physically, mentally, and in their relationships.
