Military Family 360 Survey & Data Release

In 2024, MFAN released its most comprehensive data set to date, with over 10K responses, making MFAN's research the largest independent study of military family wellbeing in the ecosystem. This research continues to shape national conversations and solutions for military families, providing policymakers and partners with actionable insights.



2 | Solutions Summit

MFAN convened cross-sector leaders for our third Solutions Summit, fostering collaboration and shared strategies to address food insecurity, financial readiness, and quality of life challenges. PCS Pantry Restock Boxes

Through PCS Pantry Restock Box program, you equipped MFAN to provide 1,850 boxes to families in transition, reducing stress and supporting them through the challenges of relocation.







